
Concept Story


We have set four key goals that aim to contribute to the 17 Sustainable Goals (SDGs)

Sustainable amenities

Millennium Organics Blue Label


Shampoo, conditioner, body wash, and hand wash * Body lotion is a Millennium Organics product.

We offer the amenities of "Millennium Organics Blue Label" containing 90% or more of plant and mineral derived ingredients. It is scented with natural essential oils without using synthetic fragrances, uses carefully selected raw materials according to organic standards, such as not using ethylene, and does not use harsh preservatives such as parabens and MIT, and has antibacterial properties. It has a formula (ingredient composition) that maintains antibacterial properties due to the blend balance of essential oils and plant extracts, and we have adopted products that have a low environmental burden as a whole.

Eco-amenity / Straw mixed with raw materials

Toothbrush, bi-fold hairbrush, razor, vanity kit, body towel

It is a product that uses raw materials that contain natural straw. It is an amenity that reduces the burden on the environment by reducing the plastic usage by about 40%.



Participating in the "Book Baton Project" to deliver education through books

we have created and displayed a Book Tree with books donated by our hotel guests and employees, and donated the proceeds from the sales of those books through the "Book Baton Project" run by Room to Read Japan, a certified non-profit organization. The donations are given to improve literacy rates among children living in historically low-income areas of Asian and African countries.

Uses environmentally friendly bamboo products

Shoehorn, brush, bath trash can, trash can (2 pcs), hair dryer & hand towel holder, amenity case BOX, notepad holder, tissue case, hanger, ballpoint pen for guest room.

In order to reduce the use of plastic, we have adopted products that use bamboo material for the body.

Zero use of plastic bottles for mineral water in the guest rooms

By using the purified water server, the use of plastic bottles for water in guest rooms will be reduced to zero. The water source is drinking water from Tokyo, which is known as one of the safest and best quality water sources in the world. The water is delivered through a water purifier before use. Continuous use of controlled drinking water also helps conserve resources.




Exclusive for In-house guests Table-Style Tea Ceremony

Table-style tea ceremony experience in a space surrounded by books

The Tsubakinokai will hold a table-style tea ceremony performance in our library space surrounded by approximately 1,500 books. In a hotel space that is not a regular Japanese-style room or tea room, our in-house guests can enjoy a contemporary table-style tea ceremony performance in the lobby surrounded not by hanging scrolls or flower arrangements, but by books and traditional crafts. Also, you can relax in the Library Lounge with a set of matcha green tea and Japanese sweets.






Exclusive for In-house guests Simple KINTSUGI experience

"New beauty" created by taking good care of things KINTSUGI experience

KINTSUGI is a traditional Japanese restoration technique in which broken, chipped, cracked or otherwise damaged areas of ceramics and porcelain are glued together with lacquer and decorated with gold or other metal powder. A "new beauty" is created by taking good care of objects that Japan has nurtured since ancient times. Guests can easily experience traditional KINTSUGI using simple modern repair techniques.

We have requested supervision from Kamakura-Bori Niyodo Mr. Kenyu Mitsuhashi, who is involved in various efforts to pass on the lacquerware culture to the next generation, and our hotel staff acquired KINTSUGI instructor certification.

Brass powder and substitute gold-etching powder will be used instead of gold powder. In addition, no real lacquer is used. Instead, synthetic lacquer (URUSHI), glue, and putty are used in this modern repair technique.


